



# Q1 Which of these modes of communication do you use at least once a week?





# Q2 How would you like to stay connected? In order to connect with you during this unprecedented time, please checkmark your preferred communications methods:





## Q3 I know at least one person on the PAC







# Q5 How would you describe the level of communication from the PAC this year?





# Q6 How would you describe the value of the communication from the PAC this year?





## Q7 How would you describe the engagement from the PAC this year?




